The funding programme aims at supporting the total sum of stakeholders, but especially local authorities and community facilities, in approaching the necessary adaptation processes in Germany as early, systematic and integrated as possible and in accordance with the SDGs.

The funding programme is intended to provide targeted incentives for the strategic management of adaptation to climate change in municipalities through municipal adaptation concepts aiming for long-term, and systematic planning with supra-regional coordination. It aims to ensure that climate impacts like heat or heavy rainfall as well as the overall view is taken into account to increase the quality of life in Germany considering societal and future generation needs.

Beneficiaries shall focus on impacts of climate change at an early stage to develop and implement adaptation concepts, measures as well as strategies and structures. Funded projects need to contribute to SDGs and shall other indicators (people benefiting, resilient infrastructures and areas, new or improved institutionalized structures or processes).

The money is provided by the Federal Republic of Germany through the Federal Ministry for the Environment, Nature Conservation, Nuclear Safety and Consumer Protection. The implementation of the funding programme is conducted by the non-profit limited liability company Zukunft - Umwelt - Gesellschaft (ZUG) focusing on two priorities:

- Funding priority A for local authorities only and
- Funding priority B for a wide variety of beneficiaries
