The **European Investment Bank** (EIB) is one of the biggest investors in climate action and environmental sustainability globally, being the largest Multilateral Development Bank financier of climate action.

In the area of climate adaptation, the main investments are made in projects that anticipate the adverse effects of climate change and take appropriate action to prevent or minimise the resulting damages. For example, such investments include projects that:

- reduce the risk of floods,
- develop resilient cities,
- increase afforestation.

The EIB is an important partner in this new growth strategy, while playing a leading role in the implementation of the Paris Agreement and the Sustainable Development Goals.

The EIB provides **3 main types of products and services:**

- lending – about 90 % of its total financial commitment
- blending – combine EIB financing with additional investment
- advising & technical assistance – maximising value for money
