

The DIGITAL Europe Programme supports the European Union's twin objectives of a green transition and digital transformation while strengthening the Union's resilience and digital sovereignty.

The DIGITAL Europe Programme will reinforce EU critical digital capacities by focusing on the key areas of artificial intelligence (AI), cybersecurity, advanced computing, data infrastructure, governance and processing, the deployment of these technologies and their best use for critical sectors like energy, climate change and environment, manufacturing, agriculture and health.

The DIGITAL Europe Programme will unleash the powers of digital technologies to reach Europe's common climate and environmental goals as set out in the European Green Deal, including being climate neutral by 2050, as well as strengthen the resilience of Europe's industry and increase its open strategic autonomy.

The kind of activities that can be financed are:

- Training and knowledge sharing
- Support for investments in climate resilience measures

The funding mechanism follows the principle of co-financing. The European Commission allocates grants to specific projects, thus contributing to a defined percentage of the total costs.
