

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


National Adaptation Strategy (NAS) and National Adaptation Plan (NAP)



Share of NRRP estimated expenditure per policy pillar by 2050







Evaluate whether NRRP sufficiently allocate investments to climate adaptation to match their NAS/NAP














Share (million EUR) of National Recovery and Resilience Plans funds allocated to climate adaptation in 15 Member States (data as of January 2023)


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### Case studies: Regional promising practices

- Show good potential, e.g. to gather better data and climate-related risks or providing international exchanges on adaptation
- Not exist for long enough for a meaningful assessment (<2 years)</li>
