




Map 1: Covenant of Mayors Europe signatories and coordinators with an adaptation commitment

Assessment of adaptation progress in Europe

Findings

All Member States have

- Climate risk assessments
- National adaptation strategies and/or plans
- Governance structures and mechanisms



- Sectoral climate risk assessments & sectoral adaptation plans limited
- Governance rarely linked to body with strong political authority across sectors
- Significant gaps in investments needs ... lack of dedicated budgets for adaptation
- Nature-based solutions included to a limited extent
- Impact of adaptation measures not widely measured and remains conceptually and practically challenging
- Progress remains unclear on adaptive capacity



- Phosphate calculator created
- Following farm land
- Strategic wetland creation
- Integrated Wetlands for specific discharges
- Needs Green Bond
- Phosphate credits



Adaptation Fund, Guadeloupe, France

Blending finance

- Local Adaptation Fund
- Gather and reorient public and private budget
- Aim for a permanent fund targeting specifically climate adaptation.
- For Sustainable Tourism & Agriculture projects on
 - Governance
 - Nature-Based Solutions
 - Technology
 - Behaviour change
- Pilot call closed Fund being tested now
- Current budget
 - €300,000 from ADEME (French Ministry)
 - €150,000 from Banque des Territoires
 - Negotiations with French Development Agency, the Water Office or the Regional Council of Guadeloupe
