


Guidance to Member States for updated NECPs 2021-2030

"Under Article of the Governance Regulation, MS must establish a **multilevel energy and climate dialogue**. They must provide a platform to discuss with stakeholders the different scenarios envisaged for energy and climate policies and achieving the EU's climate neutrality objective set out in the Climate Law."

NECPlatform added as a good example MS should follow in the EU Commission guidelines.








What is NECPlatform project?

The NECPlatform will support six EU MS in setting up and managing permanent multilevel Climate and Energy Dialogue (CED) Platforms, as mandated by Article 11 of the Governance Regulation. These dialogues will help foster vertical and horizontal integration of energy and climate policies.


30 months duration (started in October 2022)








Core institutional arrangement:


