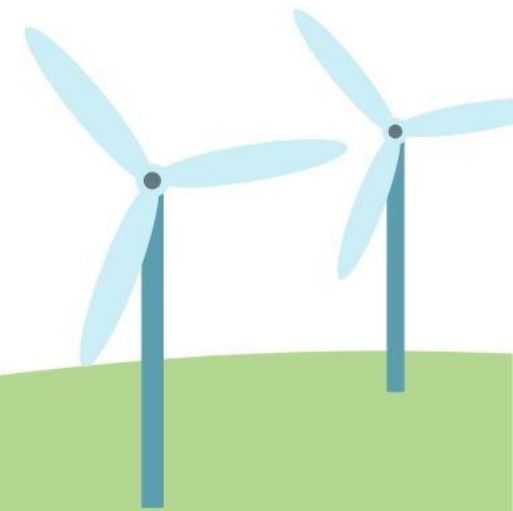

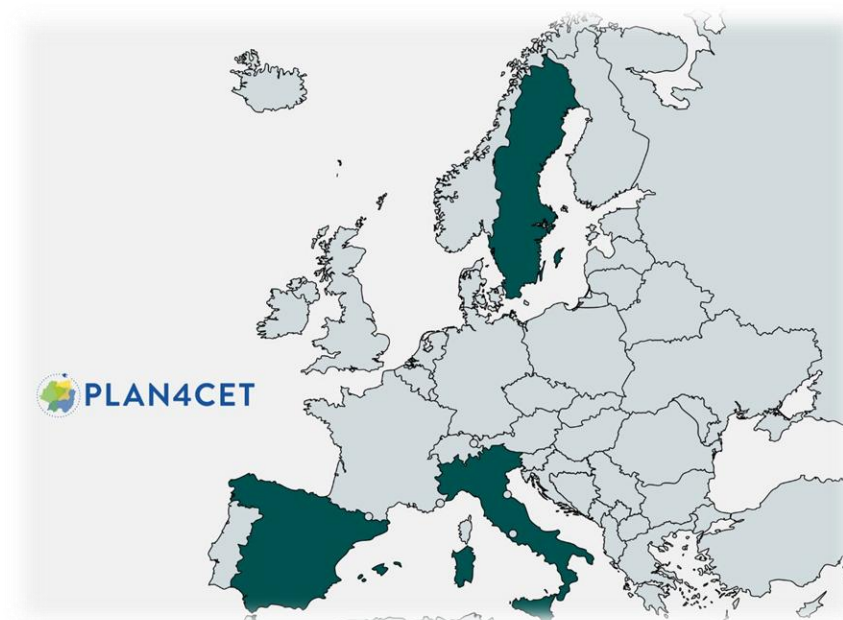
# Plan4CET Project: a quick overview

**Main objective:** to support European regions and cities in the design, development, and implementation of Clean Energy Transition plans tailored to their needs and possibilities.

## How?

1. Supporting the institutionalization of CET Governance (horizontal and vertical), mobilizing local actors, creating opportunities for participation, co-creation and engagement with multiple actors.
2. Executing integrated and intersectoral CET planning.
3. Developing capacities and provide specialized support to municipalities and regions.

**3 Pilot regions:** Navarra (ES), Skåne (SE), Parma (IT)

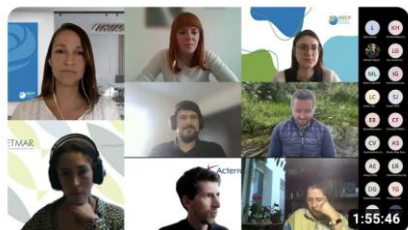

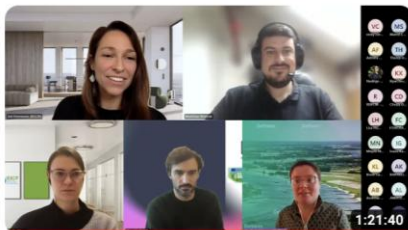
