Plan4CET Project: a quick overview


Main objective: to support European regions and cities in the design, development, and implementation of Clean Energy Transition plans tailored to their needs and possibilities.

How?

- 1. Supporting the institutionalization of CET Governance (horizontal and vertical), mobilizing local actors, creating opportunities for participation, co-creation and engagement with multiple actors.
- 2. Executing integrated and intersectoral CET planning.
- 3. <u>Developing capacities and provide specialized support to municipalities and regions.</u>
